

Sweet Little Something Z-Fold Card Project Sheet

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Supplies:

Stamps & Bundles: Sweet Little Something Photopolymer Stamp Set (2018 Occasions Catalog)

Ink: Soft Suede, Crumb Cake, Sahara Sand Classic Ink Pads

Paper: Powder Pink & Whisper White Card Stocks, Fresh Florals Designer Series Paper Stack, Medium Whisper White Envelope

Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Simply Scored, Paper Snips, Big Shot, Layering Ovals Framelits Dies

Embellishments: Pearl Basic Jewels, Powder Pink ½" Finely Woven Ribbon

Adhesives: Snail Adhesive, Stampin' Dimensionals, Glue Dots

Directions:

1. Cut Powder Pink card stock 4 ¼" x 11", score at 2 ¾" and 5 ½" on long side. Fold card in half then fold the 2 ¾" flap back to form the z-fold card base.
2. Cut Fresh Florals Designer Series Paper 2 ¾" x 4" and adhere to front card flap using Snail Adhesive.
3. Cut 2 pieces of Whisper White card stock 2 ¾" x 4" and 4" x 5 ¼". Adhere to insides of card base using Snail Adhesive.
4. Cut ½" x 4" piece of Fresh Florals Designer Series Paper and adhere to right side of large Whisper White card stock piece as shown using Snail Adhesive.
5. Cut scallop oval from Powder Pink card stock using the Big Shot and the largest scallop oval from the Layering Ovals Framelits Dies. Adhere to left front flap of card base as shown with Snail Adhesive. Be sure you are putting adhesive on the correct half of the scallop oval before securing to card base.
6. Stamp the bunny. There are three stamps to make the bunny image complete. I stamped from most detailed to least detailed and darkest color to lightest color.
 - Step 1: Stamp most detailed bunny image on Whisper White card stock using Soft Suede ink pad.
 - Step 2: Stamp next most detailed bunny image with Crumb Cake ink. TIP: I use the bottom of the bunny and the underneath of its arms to properly align one image on top of the other.
 - Step 3: Stamp the least detailed bunny image with Sahara Sand ink again using the bottom of the bunny and underneath its arms to align image on top of the others to complete the bunny.
7. Fussy cut the bunny with Paper Snips and adhere to scallop oval using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Embellish bunny with "pearl necklace" using Pearl Basic Jewels.
9. Embellish bunny ears with "hair bows". Tie knot in two pieces of Powder Pink ½" Finely Woven Ribbon, trim ends short, and adhere each to bunny ears as shown using Glue Dots.
